

How are the fees for Community Health services decided?

“Subsidised Services”

“Subsidised services” means funding is received for part of your service (either State or Federal funded) and you pay a co-payment towards your treatment.

An assessment will be completed to determine your eligibility for subsidised services. If you are eligible, you will then be asked questions about your household income and number of dependants to determine your co-payment amount.

“Non-funded fee”

“Non-funded fee” means that there is no funding to assist you with paying for service.

You will be required to pay the full fees for service.
